Faculty Meeting¹

Tuesday, January 9, 2018

The meeting was called to order at 10:05 a.m., once a quorum was reached. The following people were present for at least some portion of the meeting.

Dean Pareja called the meeting to order at 10:05 am.

ACTION ITEM:

The faculty first considered whether to request a second hire from the pool of applicants for a business and/or IP faculty position. A motion was made and seconded to make a second offer to a candidate in the pool, without identifying which candidate. The motion was followed by discussion. The motion passed with 18 yes votes, 4 no votes, and one abstention.

ACTION ITEM:

The faculty then considered the candidates who had passed the 40% acceptability round and the 60% offer round in the last faculty meeting. The faculty voted, by secret ballot. Each faculty member was asked to write down only the name of the one candidate whom s/he preferred. The one with the most votes was ranked first. The remaining candidate was ranked second.

Professor John LaVelle raised a point of order. Professor LaVelle noted that, while a public body's discussion of personnel matters can occur in closed session pursuant to an exception to New Mexico's Open Meetings Act, the Act requires that the vote itself happen in an open part of the meeting, with each member's vote recorded in the publicly-available minutes of the meeting. Dean Pareja denied the point of order. Professor LaVelle moved to appeal the decision and requested a second. Nobody seconded the motion.

The meeting was adjourned at 11:46 am
