4. Dean Fred Hart was elected as A.A.L.S. delegate, and Associate Dean Desiderio was elected as alternate.
5. The University's "No Smoking" rule was reaffirmed.

STUDENT ATTENDANCE AT FACULTY MEETINGS

Recommendation I.
