MINUTES

The meeting was called to order by Dean Hart and attention was given to the following:

1. The faculty heard reports on two prospective faculty members.
2. The following motion was voted upon and carried: That Wallace Loh be offered an assistant professorship on a tenure track, with the understanding that he work on the Centrolegal project on at least a half-time basis during 1974-75.
3. Following a discussion regarding the University's tenure policy, the faculty voted on a motion which carried: That Dean Hart be given discretion to approach the Administration regarding Wallace Loh's tenure track.
4. In the event that Wallace Loh is unavailable, it was moved that an offer be extended to Professor Stumpf, mainly reserved to the Centrolegal work with the remainder of his time to be devoted to the atmosphere of the law school. The motion carried.
