MINUTES

- 6. The faculty adopted a proposal: Any student on probation who brings his or her average up to the required 2.0 will be automatically removed from probation, this motion to remain in force until revoked by the faculty.

For Semester 1, 1974-75, the ruling applies to Judith Riordan.

- 7. There was discussion, led by John Adler, of the method of scheduling examinations and of possible Honor Code violations. The dean was asked to appoint a committee to study these matters.
- 8. A motion to install bells that ring at the beginning and end of each class period failed to pass.
- 9. Professor Reynoso announced that Robert Jones will be visiting the law school during the week. Both Mr. Jones and Mr. Bob Belton have applied for the position made possible by the Title VII grant.

The meeting was adjourned.
