It is the sense of the faculty that Mr. King be counseled to curtail outside work and absences from classes. Motion passed.
- 3. Ms. Bertha Parker was invited to speak before the faculty. Professor Raushenbush moved that the suspension stand, but that she be readmitted next fall as a beginning student. Motion failed.

After discussion by the faculty, her oral petition for reinstatement was unanimously denied.
