
The meeting was called to order by Dean Hart. A motion was passed amending the minutes of the meeting of September 22, 1975, to reflect that there was discussion concerning the possibility of changing grades of F and that it was the sense of the faculty that grades not be changed. Minutes of that meeting were then approved.

Attention was given to the following:

1. Professor Ellis presented a memorandum from MALSA to the Admissions Committee (copy attached). The Admissions Committee feels that it lacks the power to grant the requests. Dean Hart referred the matter to an ad hoc committee: Ellis, Walden, Romero, Walker, Ragsdale.
2. Dean Hart presented a request from Professor Minzner for half-time status during the spring semester. The request was unanimously granted.
3. Dean Hart made announcements concerning the festivities scheduled for October 10.
4. Professor Muir presented the proposed addendum to the Policy on Tenure, Promotion and Reappointment. The discussion that followed focused on the composition and functions of the Tenure Information Committee as applied to each tenure candidate. Discussion will continue at subsequent faculty meetings.
