The Dean made several announcements about deanship openings, other positions and the meeting of the Association of Western Law Schools.



The motion as to Professor Goldberg's paper failed. The motion as to Professor Utton's paper was tabled, to be considered after Professor Utton had been consulted.

A motion from the Student Affairs Committee to abolish the requirement that student course selections must be approved by a faculty member failed.

There being no dissent, the Chair ruled that a motion from the Student Affairs Committee providing that course descriptions be circulated prior to registration had passed unanimously.
