The meeting was called to order by Associate Dean Winograd, and minutes of the meeting of May 8, 1978, were approved. Announcements were made concerning registration, book orders, schedules, deanships, and admissions.

The faculty then considered the following:

1. Petition for readmission of Robert A. Romero. Motion carried to approve his readmission on condition that he repeat all the first year courses including Programmed Studies and Advocacy and that he make substantial progress toward bringing his grade point average up to 2.0 or higher. His present quality points and those he will make are to be averaged, and he will be on probation until he achieves 2.0. Credit hours repeated will count only once toward the degree requirement of 86 hours.
2. Petition of Margaret Romero to waive a portion of the residency requirement as a graduation requirement. Petition was denied.
3. Certification of those students who have completed all graduation requirements (list attached). The list includes Robert Aragon, who will graduate in August, 1978. Motions carried.
4. Suspension of the following students. Gilbert Baca, Jose Romero, Eric Morrison, Eliseo Sisneros, Leon Boyden, Dennis Chappabitty, Eldon McCabe, Ona Savage, Julia Sanchez. Motions carried (with implied right to petition to remain in law school).
5. Placement on probation of the following students. Linda Dietz, Thomas Kalm, Juan Baca, Damon Fasthorse, Mike Mennicucci. Motions carried.
6. Continuation on probation of the following students. Jose Cabarrus, Pedro Palacios, Dave Romero, Johnson Tsosie, and Juan Valencia. Motions carried.
7. Increase in credit hours of Pre-Trial Practice (710). Motion to increase to three credits carried.
8. Goldberg announced changes in the Faculty Library procedures.
