MINUTES

Dean Hart called the meeting to order; minutes of the meeting of January 29, 1979, were approved.

Attention was then given to the following matters:

The faculty approved awarding the Juris Doctor cum laude to Richard Beitler and Mary Vermillion. Kathleen Townsend was certified as having completed all requirements for graduation.

The faculty then considered suspensions and probations. Patrick Baca and Robert Romero were suspended. There was a motion to place on probation: Jean Baines, Michael Comeau, Thomas Gonzales, Robert Jones, Nicholas Leger. An amendment to the motion, that unless their grades are brought up to the required 2.0 by the end of the next semester it will be necessary for the students to petition the faculty to continue in this law school, failed. The original motion then carried, as did a motion to place Ronald Valencia on probation.

A motion to prohibit a student from holding office while on probation, without the approval of the Dean or Associate Dean, failed. There was also discussion concerning permission of the Dean for a probated student to do outside work.


A motion to place Angela Juzang on probation carried. A motion to withhold her enrollment if she has not attained the 2.0 average failed. Eldon McCabe was continued on probation.

Dean Hart announced that the University of Detroit Law School is looking for a dean and that a program called Humanistic Education for Law Teachers is being conducted introductory in different parts of the country during the current spring semester. A brochure for this is being placed on the faculty bulletin board next to the copier.

There was a motion to commend the Moot Court team and Charles DuMars on their performance at the national competition in New York, where they reached the quarter finals. Motion carried unanimously.

Meeting adjourned.
