Gary Martone, Executive Director of Legal Aid Society of Albuquerque, spoke concerning a plan to include the law faculty as co-counsel in special Legal Aid cases through voluntary systematic aid.

Sam Deloria announced that he plans to take a year's leave of absence to serve as Deputy Assistant Secretary for Policy to the Assistant Secretary of the Interior. The person nominated for the Assistant Secretary of the Interior is Tom Fredericks, who attended the 1969 American Law Scholarship Summer Program.

Faculty then considered the petition of Baron Abrums to remain in law school. A motion to place him on probation carried.


