Dean Desiderio called the meeting to order; minutes of the meeting of August 20, 1980, were approved.

He introduced Gail Sutton-Barbere, who spoke of the grant on a jury study project under which she is working here in the law school building. Also, he reminded the faculty that Mr. Arthur Flemming would speak in Room 2401 tomorrow on an overview of civil rights in 1980.

With the new academic year under way, Dean Desiderio outlined the goals to be attained through the aid of our committees:

- a) review of our educational program as to curriculum, such as the third year program;
- b) review of our tenure policy;
- c) written plan to be developed by the law library. Toward this end Professor Julius Marke of New York University School of Law has been invited to come at the end of October to act as a consultant.

In addition, the dean indicated that he wants to institute a fund raising drive for an endowment fund apart from that of the University. He asked for suggestions as to use of such a fund and as to methods of solicitation.

The Simms Lecture account, Albuquerque National Bank, Trustee, now has accrued sufficiently to invite a possible lecturer. The dean indicated that an invitation is being extended to Fred Graham. Also, there was a suggestion to have lectures by the faculty, as has been done in the past.

As possible contributions to better understanding at the law school were monthly assemblies and a club for spouses, the first meeting being on Saturday.

Winograd presented a profile of the entering class.
