Professor Romero moved to amend the motion, with due second, that Advocacy be moved from the Second Semester, First Year back to the First Semester, First Year. This motion to amend failed. The Curriculum Committee "New Proposed First Year Curriculum", as a revised committee report duly seconded, was then voted on, and carried.
