The faculty considered, modified and unanimously approved Third Year Student Awards recommended by the Honors and Awards Committee.

Professor DuMars discussed schedules and activities related to the visit of law faculty and students from the University of Guanajuato, Mexico.

Professor Hermann discussed schedules and activities related to the visit of Federal District Judge (Michigan) Richard Enslin.

Professor Hall, Chair of the Curriculum Committee, distributed copies of the proposed academic year 1987-88 curriculum and presented a brief report on its major points. The faculty voted to return the report to committee, with additional guidance, for resolution of problems that came to light during discussion of the proposed curriculum.

The faculty discussed student and faculty credit for "co-curricular" courses and related activities. Dean Parnall reminded the faculty that such activities must be considered not only on the basis of existing faculty staffing but also in the context of possible faculty reductions.
