SUBJECT: Addendum to Faculty Meeting Minutes of 8/24/87

The paragraph on "Admissions" in the recently distributed Faculty Meeting Minutes for August 24, 1987 should be replaced with the following corrected information. Changes are underscored:

Admissions: Associate Dean Winograd reported on the status of our 1987-88 admissions. The applicant pool was up slightly and though fewer were admitted, we ended up with a larger-than-usual enrollment of 112 first-year students. For the first time in several years, no one was admitted from the waiting list. Eighty-one of the entering students were awarded their Bachelor's degrees prior to 1987. This year, females comprise 48% of the entering class, down slightly from last year. Eighty-five percent of the members of the first year class are New Mexico residents and seven upperclass students are visiting from other institutions this year. The median LSAT score of the entering class was 35 and their median UGPA was 3.26. The number of students with LSATs over 40 has increased from the level of prior years, while the LSAT and UGPA median figures have remained roughly constant.
