- I. Minutes approval: Minutes from the meetings of October, November, December, January and February were presented, and approved unanimously.
- II. Announcements:
 - A. Christine Zuni-Cruz has received the Outstanding New Mexico Women Award, sponsored by the NM Commission on the Status of Women. The awards banquet will be held on Friday, May 7 at the Hyatt Regency.
 - B. Judge Patricia Wald will address the Law School as the Order of the Coif special lecturer on April 14. She will also be addressing the Faculty at a luncheon in her honor.
- III. 04-05 Curriculum Review and Approval: The curriculum was presented to the faculty and, after discussion, was approved unanimously. Some feedback was given regarding the schedule.
- IV. Admissions Review: A compilation of feedback on the Admissions Policy, and statistics regarding admissions were distributed, and those present were given time to peruse the material.
 - A. PREPP
 1. A question from the Admissions Committee asked whether the program will be offered. Concern was expressed regarding continuing academic support; Dean Scarnecchia reported that a program is being put into action involving the Student Services professional and the LRRW instructors to watch for students identified as in need of academic support. Discussion continued regarding the requirement of attendance at PREPP, admission of applicants with lower LSAT scores and possible "stigma" from attending the program.

2. A motion was made and seconded to continue the program for the summer, and that a single letter be sent to all of the accepted applicants. Discussion included encouraging certain students to attend PREPP. At vote, the motion passed unanimously.

The meeting was adjourned at 5:40 pm.
