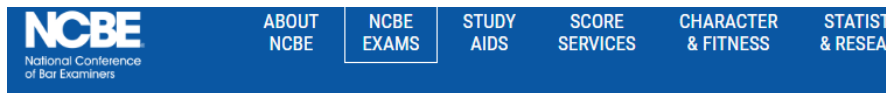

On the UBE exam, your MPT will count for 20% of your total score.
